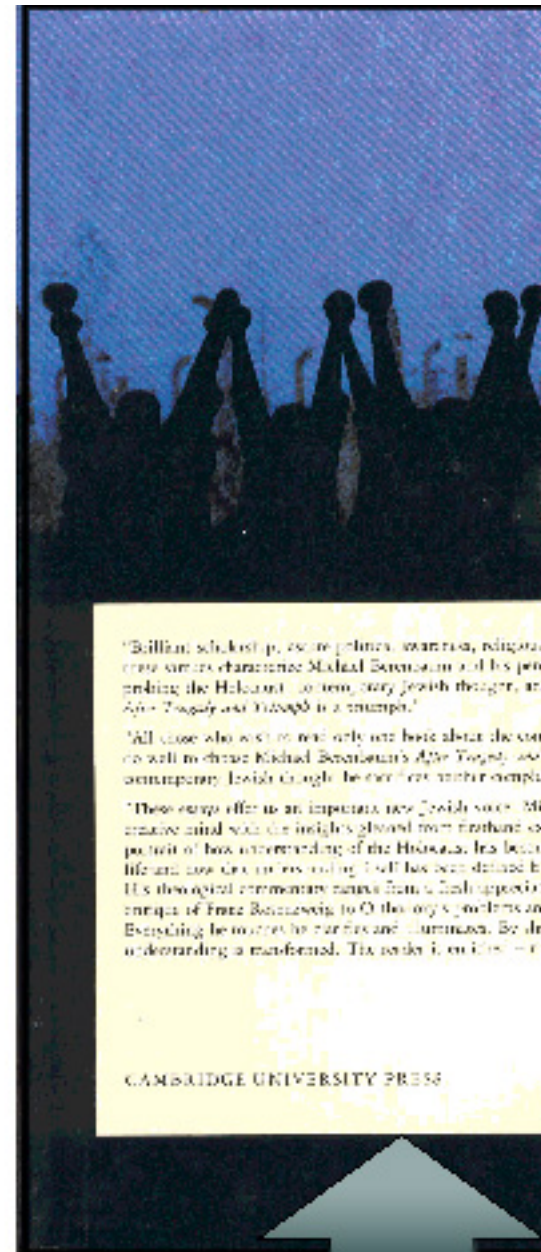
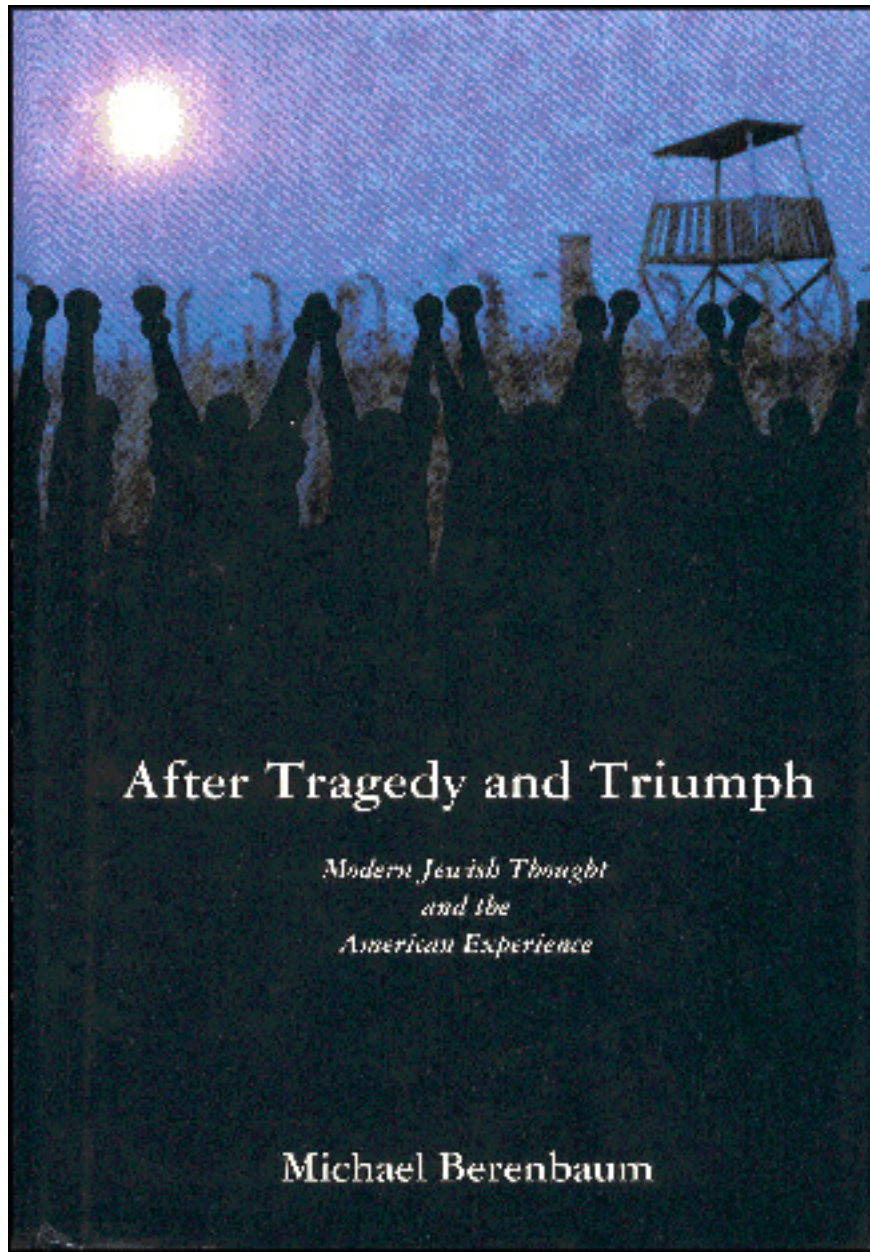

In the past he has served as Director of the Jewish Community Council of Greater Washington, Editor of the *Washington Jewish Week* and Deputy Director of the President's Commission on the Holocaust where he authored its *Report of the President*.

For his work in journalism, he won the Simon Rockover Memorial Award of the American Jewish Press Association three times in three different categories during a two year period.

Born July 31, 1945, he is a graduate of Queens College and Florida State University. Berenbaum also attended the Hebrew University, the Jewish Theological Seminary and Boston University.
